Teams	Four archers shooting the Western round one of which must be of the opposite sex or a junior shooting the western round.
Archery GB Rules	Dress: Green and/or white or club colours. This shoot will be run under Archery GB rules for outdoor shooting with 6 sighters. Please bring your Archery GB card or club receipt. Further explanation will be given by you judges on the day.
Awards	Medals will be awarded to Ladies, Gentlemen, Girls and Boys, according to entry levels. [1-3 gold, 4-9 silver, 10 or more Bronze]. Awards will be made for various bow styles.
